


- 1) Go to: http://training.rugbycanada.ca/

3) Complete the registration information and click 'Continue'.




4) You will then be taken to a page to pay the \$25.00 one-time registration fee.




5) Go to: http://training.rugbycanada.ca/ Login in with your User Name and Password.




6) Click 'Status' on the Toolbar. On this page you will see a list of all available courses.



13) After completing all required modules and uploading all certificates, click on 'Register'.




14) You can now click 'Save' to save all uploaded certificates on your Rugby Canada Training & Education page.




15) You are now able to mark your workbook as completed.
